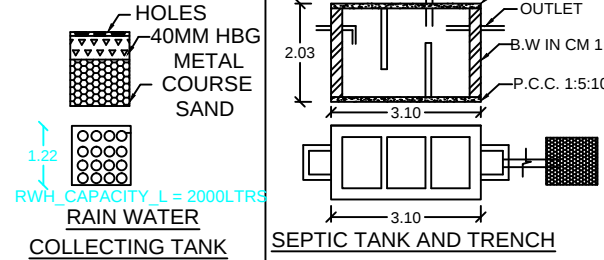
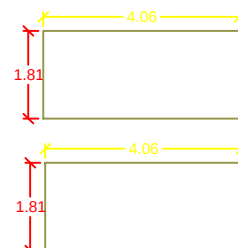

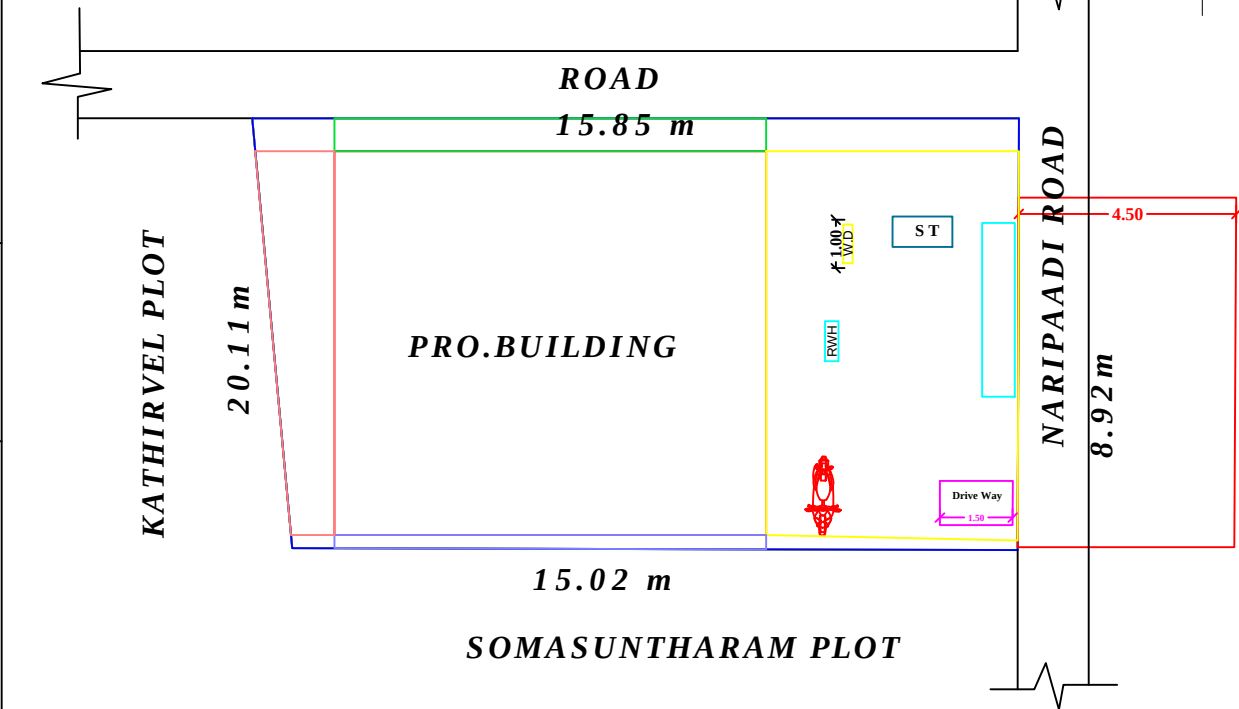

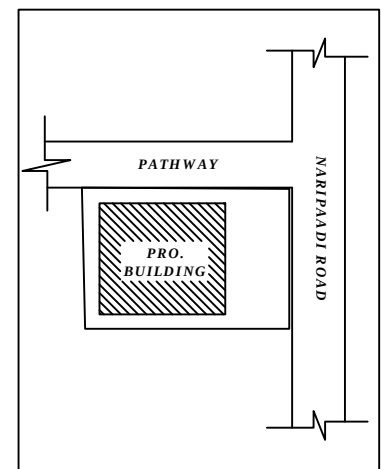
SITE PLAN
